OVERVIEW:

We explore the Paschal Mystery, learning what it means that Jesus descended into hell and that on the third day He rose again from the dead.

VOCABULARY: Descent into Hell, Resurrection, Paschal Mystery

SUMMARY:

Jesus preached the Gospel to the souls of the dead. He rose from the dead on the third day. The Resurrection is the crowning truth of our Faith. The Paschal Mystery is Christ's Passion, Death, Resurrection and Ascension.

OVERVIEW:

Although Christ reigns now in Heaven, He also reigns here on earth through the Church, His Body, His Kingdom is present and yet to come. The Church looks forward to the Second Coming of Christ with great hope and anticipation. We do not know the hour of His return, nor can we know it.

VOCABULARY: Ascension, Intercessor, Judgment Day

SUMMARY:

Forty days after He rose from the dead, Jesus ascended into Heaven. Jesus is the only Intercessor between God and man. He is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead.
