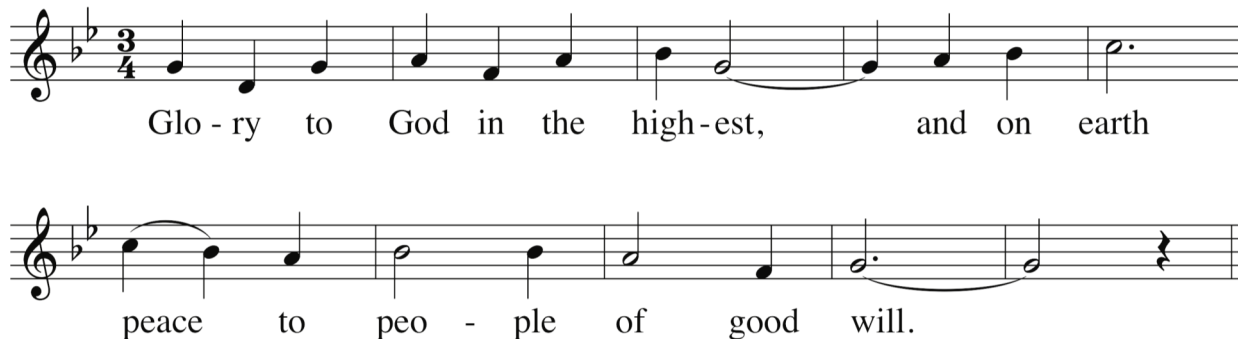

Second Reading 1 Thessalonians 1: 5-10

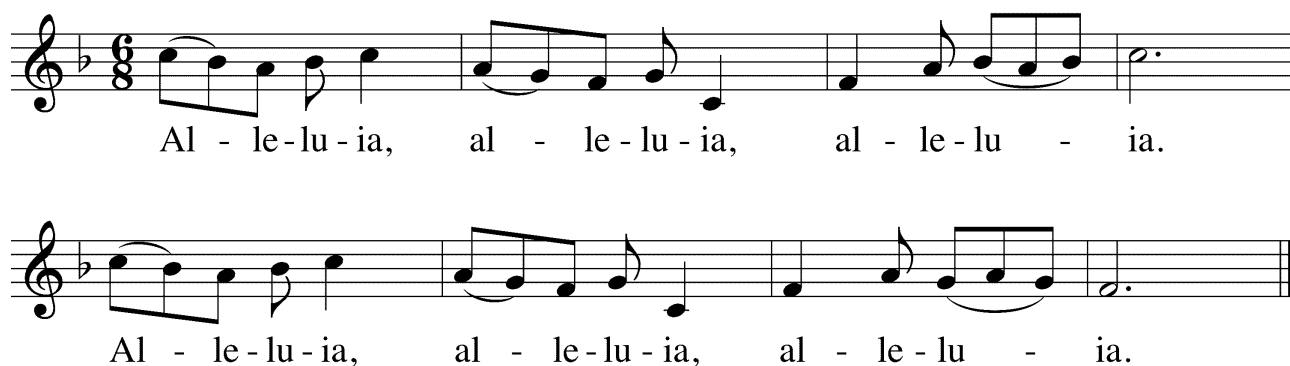


