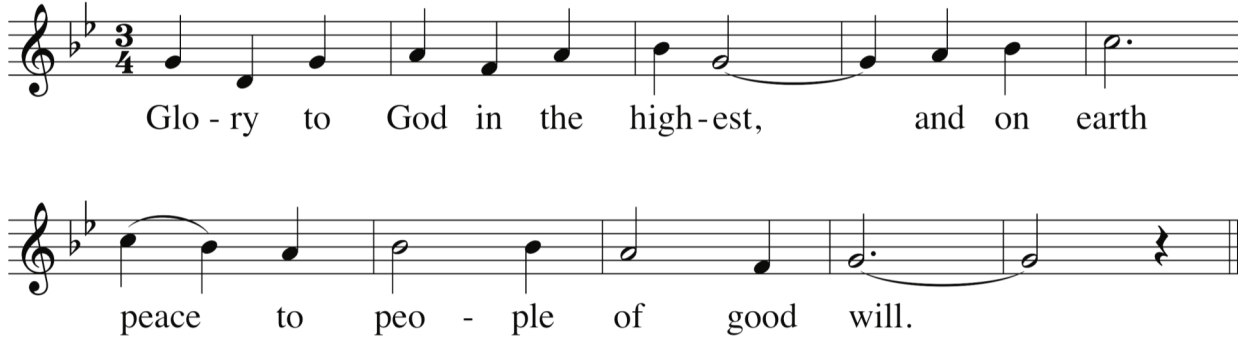

Second Reading Romans 8: 18-23

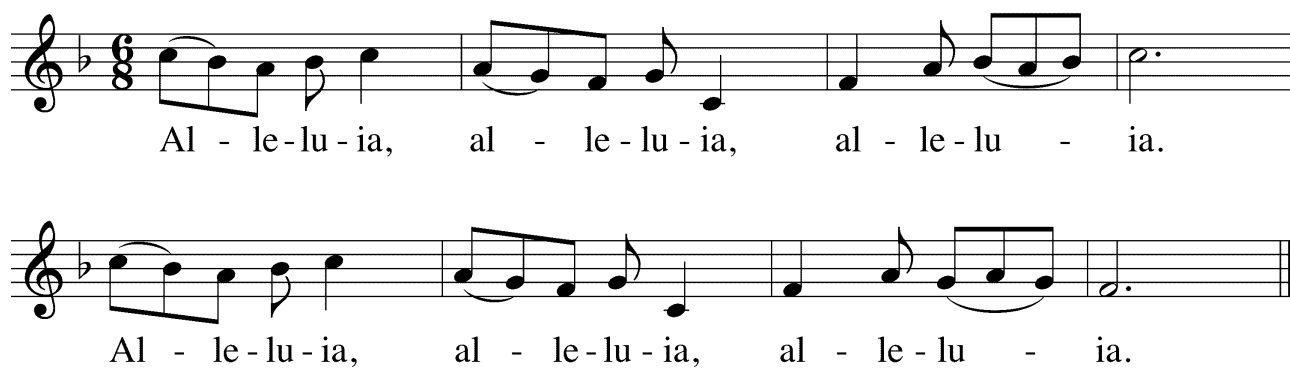

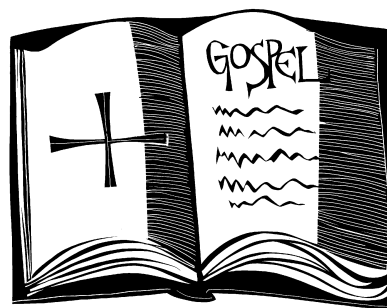


